## NOTICE TO GRADUANDS $1^{ST}$ SESSION OF THE $4^{TH}$ CONGREGATION

Undergraduate Students who have completed their programmes of study during the 2024/2025 academic year and wish to be presented for graduation during the 1<sup>st</sup> Session of the 4<sup>th</sup> Congregation Ceremony to be held on Friday, November 28, 2025, are required to take note of the following:

- 1. Verify their name on the provisional list of Graduands;
- 2. Ensure all outstanding financial obligations to the University have been fulfilled;
- 3. Pay the required graduation fee of **GH**C600.00 for undergraduates;
  - Payment may be made through any Prudential Bank branch or by using any of the following electronic options: \*772\*60# mobile money (all networks), Visa and Mastercard or via app.ropaygh.com

- 4. Graduands using bank payment would be required to present pay-in slips or evidence of payment and register at the **Academic Affairs Directorate** before collecting their academic gowns;
- 5. All graduands who wish to be presented at the 1<sup>st</sup> Session of the 4<sup>th</sup> Congregation would be required to register by the close of day on **Monday**, 24<sup>th</sup> November 2025. Only those registered by this date will be presented;
- 6. All graduands are expected to attend a mandatory rehearsal on Wednesday, 26<sup>th</sup> November 2025, @ 3:30 p.m.



- 7. Graduands should be seated thirty (30) minutes before the commencement of the Ceremony;
- 8. Graduands are expected to wear the academic gown appropriate to their programme of study, preferably over a suit or jacket with a tie for men, and court attire for women. Footwear for men should be shoes with closed lacing (Oxfords or Balmorals), and court shoes for women:
- 9. Graduands are to collect their gowns for the ceremony from the Academic Affairs Directorate, South Legon Campus, on Monday, November 17, 2025
   Monday, November 24, 2025, between 9:00 am to 3:00 pm daily;
- 10. Graduands should note that those who do not attend the Congregation ceremony will also pay the same amount before collecting their certificates;
- 11. Graduands are to return their academic gowns, ID Cards, and clearance forms before collecting their certificates. Failure to return the academic gown after one week would attract a penalty of **GH**\$\mathbb{G}\$500.00;
- 12. Only graduating students and **two (2) guests** with official invitation cards would be allowed entry to the Forecourt for the ceremony. Other family members and friends are implored to follow the ceremony online;
- 13. The list of graduands to be presented during the 1<sup>st</sup> Session of the 4<sup>th</sup> Congregation Ceremony will be available on the University's website: www.unimac.edu.gh by the Monday, November 3, 2025;
- 14. Arrangements for the collection of certificates and other relevant information will be shared on the University website: www.unimac.edu.gh.
